Subordinate Conjunctions: Takes into account five (5) factors --  
(1) Time: when, after, as soon as, whenever, while, before;  
(2) Place: where, wherever; (3) Cause: because, since, in order that, so that; (4) Contrast/Concession: although, as if, though, while; and (5) Condition: if, unless, provided, since, as long as.

The presence of coordination is often signaled by the appearance of a coordinator ( coordinating conjunction ), e.g. and, or, but (in English). ## **Grammar - Pearson**

Subordination as a concept of syntactic organization is associated closely with the distinction between coordinate and subordinate clauses. One clause is subordinate to another if it depends on it. The dependent clause is called a subordinate clause and the independent clause is called the main clause (= matrix clause).
