Implementing the 4-blocks literacy model (Book, 1997 ...

Developed more than a decade ago by literacy experts Dr. Patricia Cunningham and Dr. Dorothy Hall in conjunction with first grade teacher, Margaret DeFee, Four Blocks is a balanced-literacy* framework for teaching language arts in grades 1-3. The Four Blocks program -- based on the premise that all

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children don't learn in the same way -- integrates four language arts areas into reading instruction.

The Four Blocks Literacy Framework was developed in 1989 by first-grade teachers Patricia Cunningham and Dorothy Hall. Since then, it has been widely adopted as a balanced literacy program for use in kindergarten through fifth grade.

What Is the Four Block Reading Program? | The Classroom

Each of the four blocks must be given at least 30 minutes. The Guided Reading Block can use an extra 5-15 minutes if the time is available. The extra time, however, can not be taken from the minimum time (30 minutes) of any of the other three blocks.

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the five words given by the teacher. Then they will say, chant, use the word in a sentence, write the word and finally check the word.
