Persuasion is written with third person limited omniscient narration, and mainly focuses on Anne. While we do sometimes have scenes that Anne wasn't present for, Austen mainly gives us the events of the novel through Anne's eyes and ears, and largely through retelling of events by other characters, or overheard conversations.
